
CONGRATULATIONS TO THE BCC'S 2012 BIZI EMANKORRA RECIPIENTS

BCC REGULAR MEMBERSHIP 21 YEARS OLD

BCC Regular Membership for persons 21 years of age:

- The fee for a Regular Membership for children of Regular Members who are 21 years of age shall be \$1,000, until their 22nd birthday.
- 2. The fee for a Regular Membership for persons who are 21 and who are of Basque ancestry shall be \$1,500, until their 22nd birthday, and this Regular Membership will be nontransferable for ten (10) years.

2012 MEMBER FUNCTION LUNCH PRICE CHANGE

Beginning in 2012, the new lunch price for our members' major functions such as Palm Sunday, Mother's Day, Christmas, etc... will change. Due to rising food and labor costs, the Catering Board saw this as a necessary price increase. It is also our hope that this way we will be able to continue to serve high quality meals for our members. New prices for members' functions will be \$20 for members, \$25 for member's guests and \$30 for non-members. The new dinner price for our anniversary and August festival will be \$30. Regular Sunday lunch prices will stay the same.

The Children's lunch price will remain at \$7 however their menu will differ from the adult menu. For example, they may be served hamburger or chicken nuggets because of the increase in food costs.
