# PREMIERE BASQUE ROCK GROUP COMING TO THE BCC



**GATIBU**, one of the Basque Country's most successful and popular Basque Rock bands, has been selected to perform an the Smithsonian Folk Life festival in Washington DC and will do a concert at the **Basque Cultural Center on Thursday night**, **June 30th - 8:00pm -** free admission.

Gatibu is a Basque rock group founded in 2002 in Gernika-Lumo, a four-piece band which has brought out five studio disks and a live disk to date. From their first songs it was

very clear the group had been born to be part of one of the most widely-spread types of music in Basque culture.

Their musical style is colorful Western Basque, full of melody and life - the force of rock splashed with pop melodies with songs about love and friendship, emotions and changes in mood in daily life.

## BASQUE CINEMA DIRECTORS COMING TO THE BCC

The 2016 edition of the Basque Film Series continues this spring and fall and will feature appearances by distinguished Basque Cinema directors. On Friday, June 24th Emily Lobsenz will present her documentary, Song of the Basques, which made its premiere at Jaialdi last summer in Boise and had been selected by the Smithsonian Institute to screen last month in Washington, DC.

Later this fall, Basque film director Asier Altuna Iza will be presenting his latest film AMAMA to several Basques Clubs in the United States and will be at the BCC on Friday, October 7th. AMAMA made its world premiere at the Donostia International Film Festival this past September and was awarded the IRIZAR award for the best

Basque film, and later received seventeen Goya nominations. Mr. Altuna had previously presented his documentary BERTSOLARI at the Basque Cultural Center in 2012.


